<p>Y2Y Update: Rhiannon Keen and Kerigan Bennett presented the Y2Y updates to the board. Rhiannon and Kerigan discussed the themes for December is Depression and Anxiety.</p> <p>During the last Y2Y General meeting, Y2Y members completed stress reliever boards, a PSA, and Depression and Anxiety flush facts.</p> <p>Jen Witchita suggested that Y2Y also complete their flush facts in Spanish.</p> <p>Y2Y presented to Guppy (Green County Prevention Professionals for Youth) on December 8th. The members of Guppy enjoyed the presentation. The Y2Y presentation has inspired Guppy to start Y2Y groups throughout Green County.</p> <p>The Y2Y officers are also offering QPR training for the teachers on February 23rd. After the training attendees will be Certified Suicide Gate Keepers.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Jen Witchita suggested that Y2Y also complete their flush facts in Spanish.
<p>Selfie Campaign: Y2Y was mentioned in CADCA’s national monthly newsletter. Megan Chapman from Department of Justice reached out to Kathy and Shay. Megan expressed the idea of spreading the Selfie campaign statewide. Kathy and Shay was contacted by Lindsay Patterson from Lodi Community Action Team coalition regarding the Selfie Campaign. Shay sent the Selfie Campaign information to Lindsay.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Kathy and Shay will talk to Megan regarding the details of the State Wide Selfie Campaign and provide Y2Y and the Better Brodhead with an update.
<p>Social Host : Kathy presented the Social Host Law to the coalition. In 2016 in Fon Du Lac, a father was given a \$1,000 fine after hosting a high school graduation party for his son. The Wisconsin Supreme Court ruled in the</p>	

<p>favor of the plaintiff because the word “premises” was misapplied to homes rather than just licensed businesses. Due to this case the Social Host law, was revised and now the law applies to homes as well. Adults who host may have to pay a fine of 500.00 dollars.</p> <p>For 2018 Parents (Adults) Who Host campaign, the coalition can educate the community about the revised Social Host Law.</p> <p>Julie Sherman is also doing a training on alcohol policies on January 3rd at 4:30pm.</p>	
<p>POLD: Shay presented POLD to the coalition. (Place of a last drink) is an effort used to reduce drunk driving. The Wisconsin Alcohol Policy Project uses POLD data to reveal patterns of over serving licenses repeatedly named over time. It is illegal to sell or serve alcohol to a visibly intoxicated person. Kathy talked to Chief Hughes regarding implementing POLD in Brodhead. She will present at another meeting with Green County Sheriff department, so Better Brodhead can receive POLD data throughout Green County.</p>	
<p>STR Grant: Better Brodhead will partner with Green County Community Coalition, Green County Human Services AODA Dept., Health dept. Safe Kids Coalition, and Pinnow Pharmacy to plan and implement activities for the grant. The funds from this grant will be used to purchase medication lock boxes and bags, Prescription drug deactivation units, Dose of Reality Education materials and two town hall meeting. In addition the grant will support a Narcan Training for Public Safety Professionals, and a lunch and learn event for health care professionals on Neonatal Abstinence Syndrome.</p>	
<p>Hidden In Plain Sight: Better Brodhead is hosting Hidden in Plain Sight events the following dates in January 12th at the Guppy meeting, January 23rd at the Optimist meeting.</p> <p>The coalition also discussed completing a Hidden In Plain Sight on February 23rd using a locker or back up.</p>
