<p>Opioid Crisis prevention Services Grant :</p> <p>Kathy presented the new grant to the coalition. She noted it is a state grant worth \$7,300. The grant has to be spent by April.</p> <p>The grants focused will be county wide, working with county and local partners. The grant will be used to purchase medication lock boxes and bags, Prescription drug deactivation units, Dose of Reality Education materials. In addition the grant will support a</p> <p>Narcan Training for Public Safety Professionals, and a lunch and learn event for health care professionals on Neonatal Abstinence Syndrome.</p> <p>The coalition thought it would be a great idea if Brodhead School District had Narcan on site. This would most likely require a new policy and procedures for narcan to be available at schools.
